Traffic Arrest(s):

On 11/25/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 1100 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Cliffina T. Johnson**, 37, of Waukegan, was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed her driver's license was suspended. Johnson was issued citations for Speeding and Driving While License Suspended. Johnson was released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 11/26/2017, an Officer stopped a motor vehicle within the 600 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Elnora L. Williams**, 58, of Racine, Wisconsin, was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Williams was issued citations for Speeding, Illegal Transportation of Alcohol, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC over 0.08. Williams was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.
