### Traffic Arrest(s):

On 02/11/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of 9<sup>th</sup> Street and West Broadway Avenue for speeding. The driver, **Daniel Lee Wilbanks**, 46, of Kenosha, was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests.
