Traffic Arrest(s):

On 01/01/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of 12th Street and Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Benny M. Arroyo-Trinidad**, 20, of Kenosha, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed he had a suspended driver's license. Arroyo was issued citations for Driving While License Suspended, Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Attempted Possession of a Vehicle Title with Complete Assignment. Arroyo-Trinidad was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 01/06/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1300 block of Sheridan Road for Speeding. The driver, **Alexander F. Wray**, 23, of Waukegan was issued a citation for Driving While License Suspended. Wray was released on scene by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 01/07/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1200 block of Sheridan Road for Speeding. The driver, **Marc J. Sanders**, 25, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. During a tow inventory search of the motor vehicle; a loaded 9mm firearm and open alcohol was located inside of the motor vehicle. Sanders was issued citations for Speeding, Illegal Transportation of Alcohol, Driving Under The Influence of Alcohol, and Unlawful Use of a Weapon. Sanders was later released by a personal recognizance bond pending a future court date.

Theft of Services:

On 01/01/2018, Officers were dispatched by a local taxi cab company within the 1200 block of South Park Avenue related to a theft of services. The complainant advised a subject failed to pay \$26.20 USD for a taxi ride. Upon further investigation and interviews resulted in the subsequent arrest of **Charlie K. Henry**, 25, of Spotsylvania, Virginia. After reviewing the facts of this case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office; Henry was issued non-traffic citations for Theft of Services, Forgery, and Obstruction of Justice. Henry was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.
