Traffic Arrest(s):

On 01/13/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 700 block of Sheridan Road for speeding. The driver, **Kathrenia J. Trimmer**, 26, of Pleasant Prairie, Wisconsin was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Trimmer was issued citations for Speeding, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC over 0.08. Trimmer was later released by a Personal Recognizance bond pending a future court date.

On 01/14/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1100 block of Sheridan Road for speeding and failure to wear seatbelt. The driver, **Eric D. Grieshaber**, 22, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests.
