Traffic Arrest(s):

On 01/21/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 1400 block of speeding. The driver, **Quinton T. Peet**, 27, of Zion, was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Peet was issued citations for Speeding and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. Peet was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date.

On 01/21/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of Landon Avenue and 9th Street for speeding. The driver, **Anthony K. McClinton**, 25, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed he had an active out of state arrest warrant from the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. The front seat passenger, **Selena N. Johnson**, 19, of Zion was later subsequently taken into custody and later issued a citation for Unlawful Consumption of Liquor by Minor. Johnson was later released by a notice to appear pending a future court date. McClinton was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.

Domestic Battery:

On 01/19/2018, Officers were dispatched to the lobby at the Winthrop Harbor Police Department related to a report of a domestic battery. The victim advised she was previously struck and dragged onto the ground by her ex-boyfriend, **Eugen Braychenko**, 46 of Winthrop Harbor. After further investigation had been conducted by the Officers resulted in

the subsequent arrest of Braychenko. After reviewing the facts of the case with the Lake County States Attorney's Office; Braychenko was issued two citations for Domestic Battery. Braychenko was later transported to the Lake County Jail pending a bond hearing.
