Traffic Arrest(s):

On 05/17/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 400 block of Sheridan Road for Speeding. The driver, **Angel L. Rosario**, 26, of Chicago was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed his Illinois Driver's License was suspended. Rosario was issued citations for Speeding, Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, and Driving While License Suspended. Rosario was later released by a notice to appear pending a future branch court date.

On 05/20/2018, an Officer stopped a vehicle within the 500 block of Kenosha Road for speeding. The driver, **Willie Eaton**, 49, of Chicago was subsequently taken into custody after the Officer confirmed his Illinois Driver's License was suspended. King was issued citations for Driving While License Suspended and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol. King was later released by a personal recognizance bond pending a future court date.

Morales**, 45, of Zion was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. Morales was issued citations for Speeding and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol.
