Traffic Arrest(s):

On 03/15/2019, an Officer was dispatched within the 2700 block of 11th Street related to a disorderly subject. The driver, **Mandy M. Leong**, 41, of Winthrop Harbor was subsequently taken into custody after failing field sobriety tests. A search of her possession was conducted by the Officer which resulted in the subsequent seizure of a “Vape Pen” containing “THC oil.” Leong was later issued citations for Operation of an Uninsured Motor Vehicle, Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Driving While License Suspended, Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol, and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol with a BAC over 0.08. Leong was later released by a personal recognizance bond pending a future court date.

On 03/15/2019, an Officer stopped a vehicle near the intersection of 9th Street and Kimberly Avenue for speeding. The driver, **Shantell L.
