


SNOW REMOVAL INFO



Snow Removal: Winthrop Harbor's Department of Public Works is ready to set their snow and ice removal operation plan into motion to have the streets cleared and motorists on their way as quickly and safely as possible.

Streets: The Village plows approximately 85 lane miles of streets, which are divided into five/six sections with a truck assigned to each route. Snow removal on streets could take up to six or seven hours to clear all streets.

Parking on Streets: Residents can help WHPW by NOT parking your vehicles on any public street any time within a 24 hour period of two or more inches of snow or when snow removal is in progress. Illegally parked cars that are interfering with snow plowing operations will be ticketed and towed at owners expense.



Helpful Information

-Please **Do Not** "Crowd the Plow," our trucks are driving slower and need plenty of room, use caution when passing a truck.

-Salt trucks are spreading rock salt and drive slower than traffic, please do not tailgate a truck.

-You should know we **DO NOT** plow the following county roads:

- 9th street (West of Sheridan Rd)
- Lewis Avenue
- Kenosha Road
- Russell Road

Sidewalks

The village encourages all residents to clear their sidewalk for safety of pedestrians. The Village will plow sidewalks within the approved "School Zone" after **4 inches** of snow.
